Dr. Lynch is a Professor of [Political Science](#) at the University of Pennsylvania. She holds a PhD from the University of California, Berkeley and a BA from Harvard University. Her research focuses on the politics of public health, social policy and inequality in the rich democracies, particularly western Europe.

At Penn, she co-directs the [Lauder Institute](#) and the [Penn-Temple European Studies Colloquium](#). She is also on the advisory boards of the [Leonard Davis Institute of Health Economics](#), the [Italian Studies Program](#), and the Bioethics minor, and faculty director of the European Studies minor. She currently represents the Political Science department on the [Executive Committee of the faculty senate](#).

She edits [Socio-Economic Review](#), a multi-disciplinary journal focusing on analytical, political and moral questions arising at the intersection of economy and society, and serve on the editorial boards of [Perspectives in Politics](#), [Comparative Political Studies](#), [Journal of European Social Policy](#), and [Journal of Health Politics, Policy and Law](#). In the wider world, she is an expert advisor to the [World Health Organization's European regional office](#), past chair of the Health Politics and Policy section of the American Political Science Association, and past treasurer of the [Council for European Studies](#).
